Edward E. Baptist teaches at Cornell University, where he is an associate professor of history and the House Professor-Dean of Carl Becker House. His latest book, *The Half Has Never Been Told: Slavery and the Making of American Capitalism* was published by Basic Books in September 2014 and immediately attracted much attention. Its unfavorable review in *The Economist* was retracted after a positive firestorm of outrage. Consequently, the book has been reviewed in many high-profile non-academic media outlets, and it is also garnering academic kudos as well.
