

The Department of History is pleased to announce the 2018-2019 competition for the **Henry J. Voegtle Fellowship on the History of Florida or Southern U.S.** This fellowship is awarded to conduct undergraduate or graduate research addressing issues in the history of Florida or Southern U.S. history. Preference will be given to those undergraduate projects involving Florida and using archives and libraries away from Miami. Students meeting the eligibility criteria are invited to apply for the *Voegtle Scholarship for Research on the History of Florida or Southern U.S., 2018-2019*. The selected fellow will receive funding that can be used to conduct research. The award of up to \$ 1,000 can be used to cover research related expenses, including supplies (non-electronic), books, travel, data acquisition, and data transcription. A one-page proposal describing clearly the research project and how the funds will be used, along with a CV and budget should be submitted electronically in a single file saved with the last name of the applicant and sent to [delpinol@fiu.edu](mailto:delpinol@fiu.edu) by **September 17, 2018**. The award will be announced **by September 24** and the student shall have ten months, counted from the time of notification, to make use of the funds. After ten months the award shall expire. The recipient will be expected to produce a one-page report describing research activities and how the funds were used.
