

Darden Pyron American Cultural History Fellowship

The Department of History is pleased to announce the 2018-2019 competition for a fellowship to support undergraduate or graduate research in history by members of the department. Preference for those working on American/Southern Cultural History, Queer History, and/or Biography. The funds can cover research for a class project, offset the costs of an internship, or be used to fund a research endeavor.

History majors or minors, MA or PhD students in history, are invited to apply. The award of up to \$350 can be used to cover research related expenses, including supplies (nonelectronic), books, travel, data acquisition, and data transcription.

Applicants should submit a one-page proposal describing clearly the project and how the funds will be used. They should also submit a CV or resume. All documents should be submitted electronically in a single file to woodk@fiu.edu.
