

Digital-Online Undergraduate Fellowship

The Department of History is pleased to announce the 2018-2019 competition for the Digital Online Undergraduate Fellowship. This fellowship was instituted to support undergraduate research in the digital format by history majors and minors. Awarded annually to subsidize travel to museums, archives, and libraries; or the purchase of books, archival materials, access to digital databases, or software. Up to \$200. This research could include a class project or an internship with a museum or archive or other activities. Preference will be given to proposals using sources in the Wolfsonian-FIU collection. Awarded annually, the fellowship of up to \$200 will subsidize travel to museums, archives, and libraries, or the purchase of books or software.

Applicant should submit a one-page proposal describing clearly the project, whether for a class or an internship, and how the funds will be used. They should also submit a CV or resume. All documents should be submitted electronically in a single file to droyles@fiu.edu.
