

History Launching Fellowship

The Department of History is pleased to announce the 2018-2019 competition for the history Launching Fellowship. This fellowship of up to \$200 is awarded to subsidize the application process to any graduate program (including history programs; programs in related humanities disciplines; and programs in law, medicine, education, social work or other non-humanities fields). This award can also be used to offset the costs of the Florida Teacher Certification Exams.

The award will be given annually in fall. Applicants should be current history undergraduate students on track to graduate that fall or the following spring or summer who plan to apply to graduate schools to begin the following fall.

To apply, submit a one-page proposal describing clearly your plans for graduate school, addressing such factors as what program(s) you are applying to, why you want to go, what your planned area of concentration will be (as appropriate) and your future career plans. Also, note how the funds will be used and why they will be helpful. Include a CV or resume and an unofficial transcript.
